Lamar "Swish" Swisher, 87, of Columbia, PA, passed away Wednesday, December 8, 2021, at Luther Acres in Lititz, PA. He was born to the late Anna Swisher in Shamokin, PA, and was married to Mary (Rust) Swisher.

Lamar served in the U.S. Army and Navy Reserves as a medical technician. He retired from Armstrong World Industries as an industrial waste treatment operator and also worked at the National Watch and Clock Museum in Columbia. During retirement, Lamar worked part time as a bailiff for Lancaster County Court. He was a member of St. John's Episcopal Church in Lancaster, Columbia Lions Club, honorary member of Lancaster Liederkrantz, and many Columbia organizations.
