Leigh E. Terrill, 86, of Lancaster, PA, passed away on Tuesday, January 16, 2018 at Lancaster General Hospital. He was born in Bethany, West Virginia, the son of the late Thomas Edward and Avora (Albright) Terrill and married to Louise A. (Webb) Terrill.

Leigh was an educator for 42 years in Lancaster County. He served in the US Army during the Korean War. He was a graduate of East Stroudsburg High School, the Pennsylvania State University in 1953, and Millersville University in 1967 with a Master's in Guidance and Counseling. He was a member of The Unitarian Universalist Church of Lancaster, Free and Accepted Masons – Lamberton Lodge, NEA – National Education Assoc., PSEA – PA State Education Assoc., and PASR – PA School Assoc. of Retirees.
