Leith Anne Leed of Denver in her 51st year entered into rest after a year long courageous battle with lung cancer on Sunday, April 6, 2014. Born in Lancaster, Leith Anne was the loving daughter of the late John H. Leed and Phyllis Anne (Stack) Leed.

Leith Anne graduated from Lampeter Strasburg High School in 1982. She graduated from Empire Beaty School in 1989. She graduated from HACC with a Phlebotomy Degree in 1999. She then worked at Lancaster General Hospital for 3 ½ years. Then began working at Ephrata Hospital Lab in 2004 and was phlebotomy Supervisor at the time of her diagnosis, having to retire due to her illness in October, 2014.

Leith Anne was active in sports, having been a track and field high jumper her four years of high school. She was an avid fan of Nascar, The Philadelphia Eagles and “The Sharks” a local band of the 80’s – she loved to dance. Leith Anne and her business partner Sue Simmons operated the Manetamers in Mount Joy from 1991-1996. She then became self-employed with her own Beauty Shoppe “Leithal Beauty” from 1996-2000. Leith Anne enjoyed her 80’s Rock-n-Roll music and was known for her “Big Hair”.
