Linda Bulson Kauffman, 66, of Lancaster, PA, passed away peacefully at The Mennonite Home on Friday, November 24, 2017.

Born in Nyack, New York, she was the wife of Galen C. Kauffman and the daughter of the late Walter and Carol Longfritz Bulson. Linda and Galen celebrated their 35th wedding anniversary on January 2, 2017.

Linda graduated from Hempfield High School and Elizabethtown College, majoring in music. She worked for the Harrisburg School District as a music teacher, and was a member of the Lancaster Symphony Orchestra, playing the viola.
