Linda M. Malesic, 82 of Landisville, passed away Friday, February 13, 2026, at Penn State Health Lancaster Medical Center. She was the daughter of the late Louise and Bernard Vath of Reading, PA. She is survived by her son, Tom Malesic, daughter-in-law, Jennifer Ericson, and grandson, Ryan Malesic, of Landisville.

Linda graduated from Penn State University in 1965. During the Vietnam War, her late ex-husband, Major Joseph Malesic, was stationed in Germany. She went with him and got a civilian job teaching English and math classes to U.S. soldiers on the base. After the war, she worked as a GED instructor for the Lancaster Lebanon IU13 and was recognized as Teacher of the Year in the state of PA. In the mid-eighties, she started her own training and consulting company, Malesic Associates, in Lancaster. For nearly 30 years, she developed and conducted training programs for Fortune 500 companies, banks, and manufacturers.

Linda will be remembered for her independent spirit. If you had a dream, she thought you should believe in yourself and go for it. She believed that if you put your mind to something and worked hard, you could accomplish anything.
