Lisa Braun Storhaug, 62, passed away on Tuesday, April 1, 2025, at home surrounded by family. Born in Zaragoza Spain, she was the daughter of Sandy Russell and the late Cecil (Buz) Braun. Growing up in a military family she lived in Great Falls, Montana; Bellevue, Nebraska; San Antonio, Texas and Aurora, Colorado. Lisa graduated from Smoky Hill High School and the University of Colorado with a degree in Business Marketing.
