Margaret Elizabeth "Peg" Heisey, 96, of Calvary Homes, Elizabeth Drive, Lancaster, PA went home to be with her Lord on Monday, January 14, 2019. Born in Drumore Township, Lancaster County, PA, she was the wife of the late Lester G. Heisey who died February 17, 1993. She was the daughter of the late Clarence E. and Esther R. Myers Carter.

Peg graduated from Quarryville High School and worked on the family farm before marrying Lester; and later worked as a housekeeper on another farm. From 1958-1991, she worked at the Rheems Elementary School and Elizabethtown School District as the Head Cook and stayed on as a part time cook.

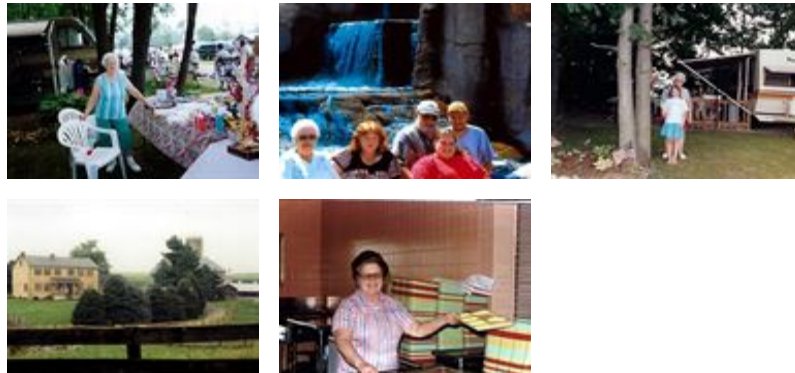
