Margaret Kathryn Simon, 97, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, August 29, 2017 at St. Anne's Retirement Community, where she resided.

Born in Philadelphia, PA, on October 26, 1919, she was the daughter of the late George A. and Kathryn L. Zecker Simon.

Margaret graduated from Stevens Girls High School in Lancaster, PA in 1937. She proudly served her country during World War II as an Aviation Storekeeper at the US Naval Air Station in Norfolk, VA. She worked for Armstrong World Industries for 38 years, retiring in 1978, as the Secretary of the Chief Economist.

Marge was a member of St. Anne's Catholic Church and enjoyed her life as a world traveler. She visited every continent except Antarctica in the 1960's through the 1980's with the Armstrong Travel Group.
