



## Marvin L. Conly

Marvin Conly passed away on Sunday, May 3, 2015 of complications from pulmonary fibrosis at age 70 at Hospice in Mt. Joy. Marvin was born in Wilmington, Delaware on September 3, 1944. He graduated from Brown-Vocational High School in 1964. After graduation he served in the Air Force doing a tour of duty in Vietnam. He was employed by DuPont as an electrical-mechanical technician. He worked on projects including an automatic clinical analyzer and day-light film processor. He also owned a gun shop in Wilmington where he made many lifelong friends. He retired from DuPont and moved to Lancaster in the early 1990's.

Marvin enjoyed boating on the Chesapeake Bay, target shooting and tinkering with anything mechanical.

He was predeceased by his brother, Dwane, who also died of pulmonary fibrosis. He is survived by his wife of 46 years, Judy Gross Conly, and their two sons. Jonathan and his partner Tiffany of Lancaster and Christopher and his wife Liz of Charleston, South Carolina. Marvin leaves two dearly loved grandsons: Skyler of Lancaster and Adam of Charlestown. His three Siamese cats will miss his good lap for naps and his good scratches.

Funeral services will be held at Trinity Presbyterian Church in Wilmington, Delaware on Thursday, May 7, 2015 at 1:00 p.m.
