Michael Giovinazzo of Lancaster, PA passed away peacefully on Tuesday, January 10, 2023. Born on June 7, 1931 in Ravenna, Ohio, Mike was the son of Rosario and Maria (Martelli) Giovinazzo. He was the first in the family to be born in the United States after his parents immigrated from Calabria, Italy. Mike was a proud Italian!

He graduated from Ravenna High School and went on to serve in the Army. He attended Kent State University where he met his wife, Mary Jane. They married in 1957. He received his BBA in 1958 and began his career at Kroger, also working for Rini's Stop N Shop, and Charley Brothers. He owned and operated several County Market supermarkets in Maryland and Pennsylvania until retiring in 2002.

Mike enjoyed traveling and was a lifelong fan of the Cleveland Browns and Cleveland Indians. He had 12 grandchildren and delighted in their various activities and was always so proud of their accomplishments. He was the "fun grandpa" who loved to offer the kids homemade milkshakes right before dinner or bedtime.

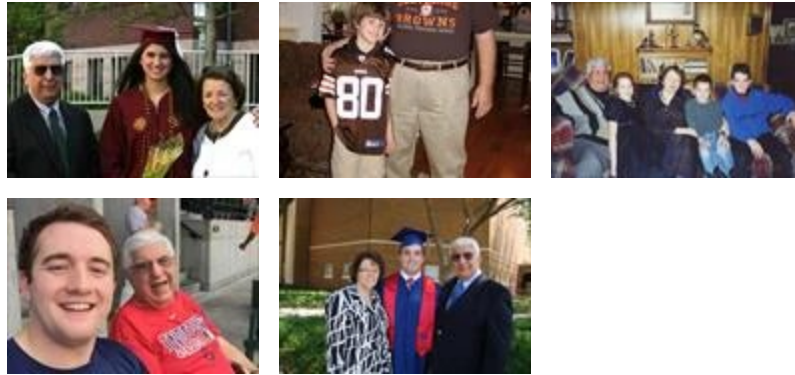

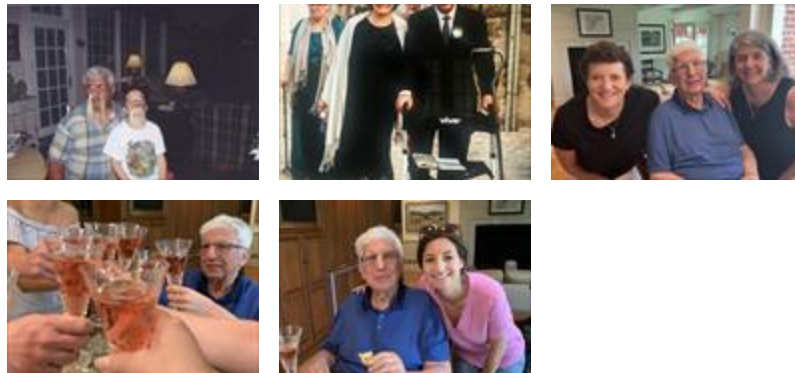
