Mildred Reichley Barth, 103, a resident of the Mennonite Home, formerly of Clearview Avenue, Lancaster, was born on November 14, 1908 in Lansdale, PA and died on Tuesday, October 16, 2012. She was the daughter of the late Mary Moyer and Charles N. Reichley.

She was a graduate of Lansdale High School and attended Brown Preparatory School in Philadelphia as well as Penn State for extra credits. She graduated from Albright College in Reading, PA. While a student at Albright College she entered a Dress designing Contest for college students from across the United States sponsored by Marshall Fields of Chicago. Out of more than 6,000 entries she won Honorable Mention.

Mildred was married for sixty years to the late Reverend Dr. George Reuber Barth who died in 2003. While her husband was pastor of Pearl Street United Methodist Church in Lancaster, she served as Secretary, Treasurer, Vice President and President of the United Methodist Women. She also chaired the Flower Committee. She was a member of Grandview United Methodist Church.

She and her husband traveled extensively in Europe, Israel, Lebanon and Scandinavia. She was a skilled seamstress, enjoyed reading and has enjoyed cooking and entertaining guests in her home.

Mildred was preceded in death, in addition to her husband, by her brothers C. Robert, George Donald, Paul H. and Richard N. Reichley. She is survived by her sister-in-law Mary R. Reichley, widow of Richard N. Reichley, nieces and nephews.

The Memorial Service for Mildred will be held on Saturday, October 20, 2012 at 10:00a.m. at the Groffs Family Funeral & Cremation Services, 528 W.
