Miles John Reel, 84 went to be with the Lord peacefully, surrounded by his family on November 21, 2014 at Manor Care in Lancaster, Pennsylvania.

Born in Wilkes Barre, PA, he was the son of the late Miles DeWitt Reel and Carolyn Gertrude Golightly Reel and was married to Shirley White Reel who died in 2006.

Miles was drafted into the U.S. Army at age 19 and served during the Korean War. He served for several years in Berlin, Germany as a member of the Peace Keeping Initiative there. He also served in the 109th National Guard.

He was a lifelong member of The Salvation Army in Wilkes Barre where he served as a volunteer and usher. He was also a member of the Men's Fellowship Club.

Miles is survived by his brother, Major Robert J. Reel, husband of Lynette Hufford Reel of Lancaster, Pennsylvania and several nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by a sister, Eleanor Smith.
