Paul H. Brenneman, 73, of Lancaster died Saturday evening, March 12, 2011 at Lancaster General Hospital. Born in Lancaster, he was the son of the late I. Hershey and Alta Hollinger Brenneman and the husband of Doris M. Grill Brenneman with whom he celebrated 54 years of marriage last August 2010.

Paul was the founder and President of Brenneman Printing, Incorporated until his retirement in 1995. Prior to starting his own business, he was an offset pressman at RR Donnelley for 16 years. He loved politics, golf and flower gardening. He especially enjoyed traveling throughout the United States as well as accompanying his grandson to national junior golf tournaments. He also enjoyed tennis, deep sea fishing and took great pride in his grandchildren.
