A homemaker, she often helped her husband, a cabinetmaker, stain and varnish furniture. She was a member of Sacred Heart Church and a former member of the Lancaster Happy Hours Club and the Blind Association. At her death, she was the oldest member of the Lancaster Liederkrantz, where she sang for many years in the chorus.

Born in Reichenbach, Germany, she was the daughter of the late Josephine and Franz Gross. Her husband, Frederick C. Seuss, died in 1992. Three brothers and a sister preceded her in death. Besides nephews and nieces in Germany and the United States, she is survived by two sons, Frederick F., husband of Urania (Rae) and John B., husband of Mary J., both of Lancaster; 10 grandchildren, 19 great-grandchildren and two great-great-grandchildren. A Mass of Christian burial will be held on Monday, July 19, 2010, at 11 a.m. at Sacred Heart Church, 558 W. Walnut St., with Rev. Michael E. Messner officiating. Family will receive friends at the church from 10 a.m. until time of the service. Interment at St. Joseph Cemetery.
