Phyllis "Poppy" Hartman Youngquist, 95, died Sunday, June 12, 2016 at Homestead Village, Lancaster, where she had lived for 21 years. Born in Lancaster, she was the daughter of the late John I. Hartman and Loneita Straub Hartman. She was married to the late Richard L. Youngquist for 68 years.

Poppy was a graduate of The Shippen School and attended Bennington College. As a young adult, she was active in the local art community and was a member of the Echo Valley Group. After raising her three children, she became involved with the Lancaster Planned Parenthood organization. Serving ultimately as Executive Director, she oversaw its move to its current location on South Lime Street. She had a lifelong association with St. John's Episcopal Church.

She is survived by a daughter, Lon Youngquist Schooley, wife of Harry B. Schooley III of Buffalo, NY; two sons, Peter L. Youngquist of Los Angeles, CA, and Jeffrey I. Youngquist of Lancaster; a brother, Robert B. Hartman of Bridgeport, CT; and a grandson, Harry B. Schooley IV of Buffalo, NY. She was preceded in death by a sister, Helen Hartman Gemmill, and a brother, John I. Hartman.
