Preston H. Kline, 98, Lancaster, formerly of Landisville, died at the Lebanon, VA, on Easter Sunday, April 21, 2019. Born in Lancaster, PA, he was the son of the late Abram and Ethel Henry Kline. He was the husband of the late Mary Jane Kline.

Preston owned the Preston Kline & Sons carpet shop and worked for Carpet Mart, retiring from Certified Carpet at the age of 93. For a short period of time, he was a real estate agent.

He was US Army veteran serving in WWII in the Pacific Theater as a Second Lieutenant in the Corp of Engineers. He was a member of the Corp of Engineers Officer Association and St. James Episcopal Church. Preston loved to golf and would do that weekly. He stopped golfing at the age of 97.

Most of Preston's happiest times were spent boating with his family on the Upper Chesapeake Bay at his summer home in Red Point, MD. He enjoyed having breakfast at Miss Calee's Eats & Treats in Landisville.

He is survived by his daughter, Debra Ann, wife of John Richard Bramble, Ephrata, PA, his son, Craig D., husband of Shirley Kline, Landisville, PA, daughter-in-law, Mary Jo Kline, eight grandchildren and 9 great-grandchildren.
