Raymond E. “Dick” or “Mumbles” Long, 82, of Lancaster, PA, died Monday, March 18, 2013, at Conestoga View. Born in Manheim, PA, he was the son of the late Cyrus and Elsie Markey Long, and husband of Martha E. Swinehart Long, with whom he would have celebrated 55 years of marriage in May.

Ray graduated in 1949 from J.P. McCaskey High School, where he was an award-winning swimmer. He served in the US Air Force from 1952-1956, stationed in Goose Bay, Labrador and Alaska. He retired in 1993 after working for 35 years with the City of Lancaster, Public Works Department. A former member of the Riverside Club, Ray was an avid fan of the Eagles and Phillies, and enjoyed listening to country music.
