Richard A. "Dick" Kurtz, 95, of Lancaster and formally of Lebanon, PA, passed away peacefully at Masonic Homes, Elizabethtown, PA on Friday, January 11th, 2019. He was the son of Elias K. and Doris Jacoby Kurtz and was the husband of the late Margaret (Peg) Dressendorfer Kurtz, who passed in 2005.
