Richard L. "Dick" Flick, 87, of Lancaster, passed away on Tuesday, June 2, 2015 at his home, following a five-year bout with lymphoma. Richard was the husband of Mary Elizabeth Ruhl Flick. Born, December 8, 1927, in Lancaster, PA, he was the son of the late Harry and Miriam Glazer Flick.
