Richard Lewis Reynolds, 88, died peacefully at his home on Sunday, June 3, 2018. Born in Newark, NJ, he was the son of the late Walter Worth and Marie Emma Kuhule Reynolds and the loving husband of Kieu T. Reynolds for 47 years.

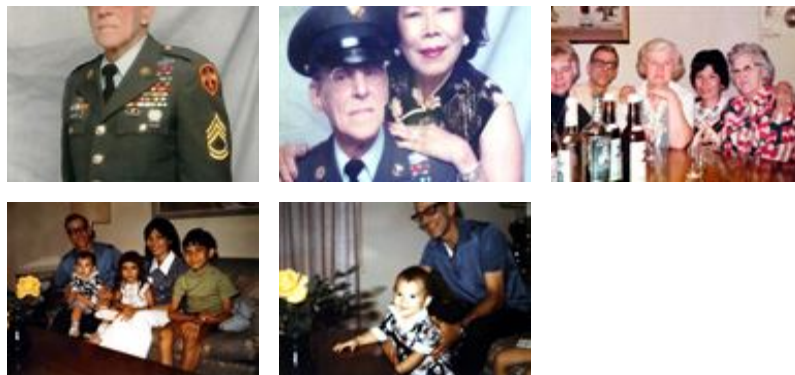
