



## ROBERT "BOB" FREISHER

Robert "Bob" Freisher, 79, of Rossmere, died unexpectedly on Saturday, May 19th, while walking with his wife, Linda (née Kenderdine), and his Irish Setter, Molly. They had been in his favorite place, Lancaster County Central Park, where he walked his dogs daily after retiring 15 years prior.

Born on April 3rd, 1933 in Lancaster, PA, he was the son of the late Elsie Kirchgessner and Joseph Freisher. Surviving in addition to his wife are his two sons: Michael, husband of Debra Eddins, and Steven, husband of Mary Dyer, both of Lancaster; three grandchildren; his brother, Paul William "Bill", also of Lancaster. He was preceded in death by one sister, Ruth.

He celebrated 57 years of marriage in April 2012. Bob worked for years in auto painting before retiring to pursue his interests outdoors. An avid fisherman, Bob enjoyed tying his own flies and travelling to scenic Kodiak Island, Alaska and Gowganda, Canada to fish. Bob held a close relationship with his dogs--always Irish Setters--who were spoiled rotten, every last one of them.
