Robert J. "Herb" Hoover, 82, passed away peacefully at his home, which he designed and helped build, on Wednesday, July 25, 2012 surrounded by his family and friends. Born in Lancaster, PA, he was the son of the late Victor E. & Mildred A. Burkhart Hoover. He was married to Cynthia Sangrey Hoover with whom he celebrated 49 years of marriage.

Herb was dearly loved by his family and friends for his wonderful sense of humor and his kind generosity. Herb served in the U.S. Army from 1947 to 1949 during the Korean conflict. He worked as a plumber for Local 520 Plumbers and Pipe Fitters and was a member for 46 years. He was a faithful member of the Mt. Nebo United Methodist Church community. He was a Free and Accepted Mason of Lancaster Lodge 43 and volunteered for Meals on Wheels. His favorite pastime was participating in the Garden Spot Bowling League. Being surrounded by family, friends and his dogs is what brought him the most pleasure.
