Robert V. Hubbard, 90, of Lancaster, PA, gently entered eternal rest on Tuesday, November 25, 2025, at the Lebanon VA Medical Center. To those who knew him, Bob was a devoted husband, a proud father, a lifelong learner, and a man whose curiosity carried him far in both distance and spirit. He is survived by Sharon (Unverzagt) Hubbard, his beloved wife, who shared countless years of life, love, and memories by his side.

Born in Evanston, Illinois to John Boyce and Carol (Smith) Hubbard, Bob grew up with a deep appreciation for nature, service, and discovery—values that stayed with him throughout his life. He dedicated 21 years to the U.S. Army, rising to the rank of Lieutenant Colonel. His military career took him around the world, including tours as an Airborne Ranger in Vietnam and Thailand, and nurtured his enduring fascination with cultures and languages. Always interested in learning, he earned a bachelor's degree in forestry management from Colorado State University, a master's in Asian studies from the University of Michigan, and a master's in psychology from Catholic University. Fluent in French and Thai, he later spent two more decades working in the public sector using his skills in service to others.

A lifelong achiever, Bob became an Eagle Scout in his youth—an accomplishment he carried with pride. He found community in the Military Officers Association of America (MOAA), the Masonic Lodge, Post 43 in

Lancaster, and through his earlier involvement with the Springfield Chorale at St. Christopher's Episcopal Church, where his love of music found a home. He was happiest when traveling, singing, or lacing up his running shoes; in his forties, he completed two Marine Corps Marathons, a point of quiet pride.

Beyond his many accomplishments, Bob also found joy in his passion for baseball. A lifelong follower of the Chicago Cubs, he traveled to many Cubs games, and he treasured the moment they finally won the World Series in 2016.

Bob is lovingly remembered by his wife Sharon, children John (wife Beth), Lisa (husband Joe), and William; his stepsons Michael (wife Kim) and Timothy (wife Lisa); his seven grandchildren; and his great-grandchild, all of whom brought him special joy.

Family and friends are invited to honor Bob's life at a funeral service held at St. Edward's Episcopal Church, 2453 Harrisburg Pike, Lancaster, PA, on Monday, December 8, 2025, at 10:30 a.m. The family will receive visitors beginning at 10:00 a.m. Interment with full military honors will follow at Indiantown Gap National Cemetery.
