Robert J. Scott, 85, of Lancaster, PA, entered the presence of his Savior and Lord Jesus Christ on Monday, December 26, 2016. Born in Niagara Falls, NY, Bob was the son of the late Frank MacCulley Scott and Mildred Ricker Scott.

He met and married Kathryn Miller Scott 48 years ago in Wheaton, IL. In addition to Kathy, he is survived by sons: Michael and Timothy of Lancaster and daughters: Deborah and Cheryl of California, granddaughter Jennifer and great-grandson, Tyler.

He was preceded in death by son, Mark who died in January, 2016; and step-mother Gladys Sheffield Scott in 1996.

After graduating from LaSalle High School in Niagara Falls, Bob moved to Chicago, IL to live with his father and attend Northwestern University, Navy Pier Campus. He served in the US Army during the Korean War.

His career in journalism began at Chicago Daily News. Then he joined the staff at Fairchild Publishers writing for Chain Store Age. He later moved to the editorial desk at other trade publications including EIP and Hitchcock. Bob served Lancaster Newspapers for 20 years as a correspondent covering Conestoga, Millersville, and Pequea Municipal meetings. He also worked as a food and supplies clerk at Lampeter-Strasburg School District, retiring in 1993.
