Rosemarie Vilma Seminara, 92, of Lititz, PA, passed peacefully on Saturday, February 3, 2024, surrounded by the warm love of her children and grandchildren. Born in Queens, NY, the daughter of Michael and Marie Sottosanti, she was the loving wife of the late Nicholas Charles Seminara who died in 1995. Those who knew Vilma, knew a strong, elegant, kind, and selfless beauty who always saw the good in others, consistent with her faith in Christ.

Vilma graduated from Marymount College of Tarrytown, NY in 1952 with a degree in English Literature and earned her master's degree in 1971 from C.W. Post of Long Island University. She taught high school English in Babylon, NY, Palmyra, PA and Warwick, PA. Vilma relocated to Lancaster in 1978 and began her real estate career in the 1980s, retiring from Lancaster Real Estate as a Broker in 2017. She was also a long-time member and a past president of the Lancaster Chapter of the American Business Women's Association.

For over fifty years, Vilma passionately advocated for the rights and opportunities of people with disabilities and served the United Support Group of Lancaster (now known as Excentia Human Services) as a member of the Board as well as a regular volunteer. She was also a member of the Lancaster Italian Cultural Society.

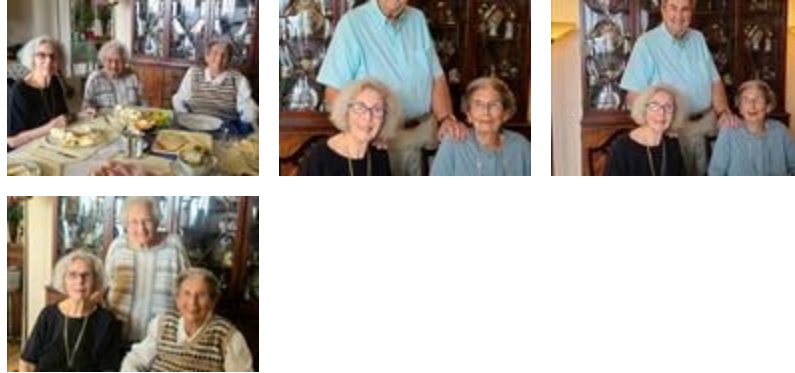
