Sally B. Proffitt, 84, died in hospice care at Oak Leaf Manor North in Landisville PA, March 31, 2015. Born in Frederick, MD, she was the daughter of the late Martin Luther and Helen Potter Bowers. She was married to the late Landon M. Proffitt who died in 2012.

Sally was a graduate of Hood College receiving a BA in music. She was a homemaker and an office manager for her husband Landon's architectural practice in Frederick, MD from 1973 until 1995, when they retired and came to Lancaster. She was an active member of Bethany Presbyterian Church in Lancaster, where she sang in the choir and served several terms on the Board of Deacons. A lover of music, Sally sang in the choir in every church to which she belonged, including Palisades Presbyterian Church in Palisades, NY and the Frederick Presbyterian Church. She also served as a volunteer in the Dean's and Admissions Offices at Lancaster Theological Seminary for twenty years.

A triplet, Sally is survived by her brother Martin, of Frederick, MD. She was predeceased by her brother Grayson, also of Frederick, MD. Surviving also are sister-in-law Lucille H. Proffitt (North Carolina), and four children: Michael L. Proffitt and partner Kate Kuranda, Anabel C. Proffitt and husband Chuck Melchert, Amy P. Robinette and husband Dale B. Robinette, and John S. Proffitt and his partner Jeanette Ide. In addition, she is survived by three

grandchildren: Anne P. Dean and her husband Stephen Dean, Charles M.F. Proffitt and partner Erin Quinn, Bradley P. Robinette, and great-grandchild, Katie S. Dean.
