Samuel Martin Myers, 93, of Lancaster, took his flight to Heaven on Friday morning, February 17, 2012 at the VA Medical Center, Lebanon, PA under the care of Hospice of Lancaster County. Born in Harrisburg, PA, he was the son of the late Samuel (Dusty) and Mabel Seabolt Myers and the loving husband of Jean E. Boettner Myers with whom he celebrated 72 years of marriage.

Sam graduated from McCaskey High School in 1939, graduated from Armstrong Supervisor School and enlisted in the Air Force in 1943. He was a member of Covenant United Methodist Church, Lancaster.

As a boy, Sam showed interest in aviation receiving his private license as a young man. He belonged to the Lancaster Aero Club, Civil Air Patrol, The Antique Airplane Association and The Silver Wings. He was for many years the owner and operator of Sam's Laundromat in Lancaster and was known for his kindness and a listening ear. 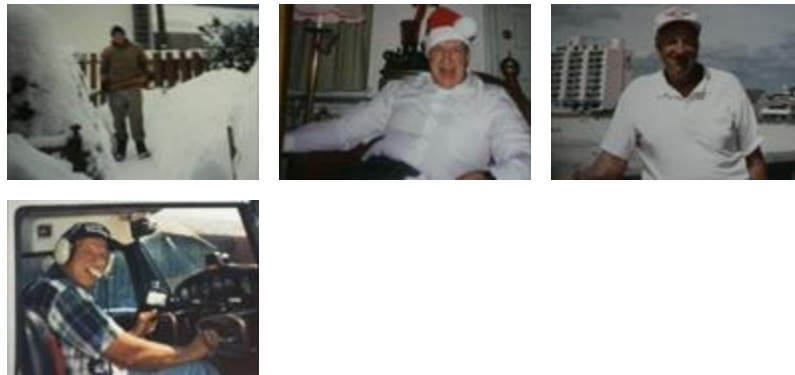
