Sandra Rankin Grove died May 15, 2026. A resident of Willow Valley Communities since 2017, Sandy was a lifelong resident of Lancaster County. For the past 40 years, she has been married to Edgar L. Grove. She spent her entire life devoted to her family.

Sandy graduated from Wheatland Junior High school, attended McCaskey High School and completed several courses at Franklin & Marshall College.

Early in her married life she was very active in the Lancaster Community. She served as President of the St. Joseph Hospital Women's Auxiliary, a member of the Junior League of Lancaster and volunteered with many community charities and organizations. Sandra and her business partner, Mary Garman Miller, owned and operated a consignment shop called The Stock Swap for several years.
