Staff Sergeant James A. Patterson, 32, of Lancaster, PA, passed away on Sunday, January 14, 2018. Born in Philadelphia, PA, James is survived by his wife, Amanda L. Patterson and his daughter, Carrera J. Patterson. He was the son of Jim Patterson and Andrea Motley, both of Philadelphia, PA.

James graduated from JP McCaskey High School in 2004, where he was known for speeding his red Volkswagen Jetta through “tornado alley,” causing the installation of the barrier poles between the two school buildings. Following high school, James earned a degree in Systems and Networking Administration from Thaddeus Stevens College of Technology in 2007. James married his high school sweetheart Amanda in 2007 and enlisted in the United States Marine Corps in 2009 as a Private First Class. In 2011, James and Amanda welcomed Carrera “CJ” Patterson into their lives. James took great pride in naming his “Baby Girl,” and in instilling a sense of confidence and integrity in his daughter. James passed on his love of video games, Chic-fil-A, Nerds candies, and salty food to Carrera. 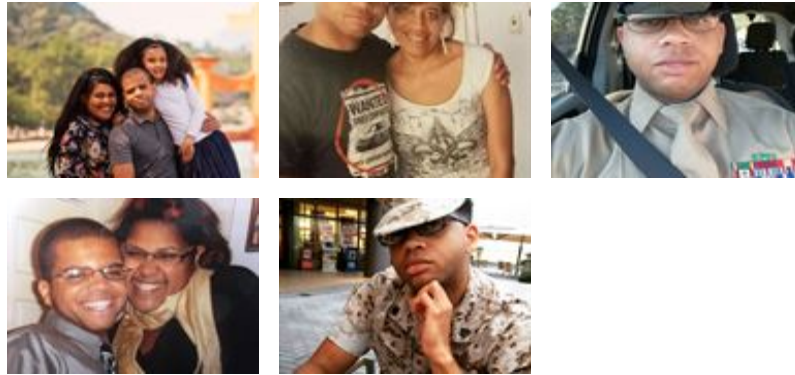
