Stanley C. Dahl, 92, of Lancaster, PA, passed away on Tuesday, August 22, 2017 at Lancaster General Hospital. He was born in Brooklyn, NY, the son of Christopher and Clara (Hess) Dahl. His wife, Grace A. (Berntsen) Dahl passed away in 2012.

Stanley served in the US Army 882 Airborne during WWII, serving in New Guinea, Philippines, and a short time in Okinawa, Japan. He retired as a sales manager after 65 years of service.
