Stanley E. "Butch" Mack, 73, of Hilton Drive, Lancaster, PA, died on Monday, April 15, 2019 at Lancaster General Hospital surrounded by his family. Born in Brooklyn, New York, he was the son of Daniel M. Mack, Bedford, South Carolina, and the late Gladys Washington Mack and his ex-wife, Virginia Mack. He was the husband of Denise Anna Kimmich Mack, who recently passed away on March 25, 2019.

Stanley graduated from J.P. McCaskey High School and attended Alvernia College. He was a member of Bright Side Baptist Church, Lancaster, PA. He retired from Dart Container working as a forklift operator. He was an alcohol and drug counselor for the former Wagon Train, which was a part of Vision Quest.

Stanley played semi pro football with the Pottstown Bulldogs and locally coached the Chargers football team (now known as the JP Tornado's). He enjoyed fishing, camping, dancing, going to concerts, "DJ ing", music, and was a collector of swords, Native American memorabilia and anything Pittsburgh Steelers. He liked to read Clive Classer books and will be remembered as the "Karaoke King." He was accepted to play on "Jeopardy" and loved telling war stories and jokes. Most of all he loved babysitting his grandchildren and loved his dogs.

Stanley proudly served his country with the United States Army, where he received three Purple Hearts. He was a great marksman and Airborne Ranger. He was a member of the VFW Post 19, AMVETS, Moose Club, Rainmakers and the Elks.

In addition to his father, he is survived by Virginia's two children, Tanya E. Mack and Stanley E. Mack, Jr., both of Lancaster and was preceded in death by her son, Kalif O.
