Stephen L. "Coach" Powell, 68, of Lancaster died on Wednesday, June 6, 2018 at Hospice & Community Care in Mount Joy. Born in Chester, PA on July 13, 1949 a son of the late Dorothy L. and Jerome E. Powell, Sr.

He was a graduate of Chester High School and earned his Teaching degree from Millersville University.

Steve was the Head Coach of J.P. McCaskey High School Boys Basketball Team for 26 years and was Assistant under Coach Horn from 1972 to 1993. Coach Powell was the winningest basketball coach in the Lancaster-Lebanon League history.

Steve was the Founder, CEO, and President of Powell Steel in Pequea Township from 1993 to 2013.

He is survived by his life partner of 42 years, Gloria J. Campbell; his children, Stephen, Aleisha, Stephanie and their mother, Janie; siblings, Ethel, Nathaniel, Kevin, Jerome, and Sharon; grandchildren, Makiyah, Syrah, Duron, and Laylah; Aunt Elsie who helped raise him and Aunt Della.

He was preceded in death by two sisters, Elaine and Elinore.
