Yet, there was also a quieter, deeply dedicated side to Taylor. A lifelong member of Boy Scouts of America, he proudly achieved the rank of Eagle Scout, Boy Scout Troop #4, in Lancaster PA. More than his accomplishments, Taylor found joy in mentoring and guiding younger scouts, inspiring them to reach their goals and build their confidence. His leadership left an indelible mark on many who will continue to carry his spirit forward.

Taylor's humor, playfulness, and sarcastic wit were most often shared with those closest to him, with a genuine warmth and love felt behind his antics. His family and friends will forever hold these lighthearted moments in their hearts.

Taylor spent his many summers growing up and making special memories on the beaches of Cape Cod. Taylor worked as a Lifeguard for the Town of Yarmouth and looked forward to the new summer seasons beginning and

once again reuniting with his fellow guards on the Cape.

A graduate of Thaddeus Stevens College of Technology with an Associate Degree in Welding Technology, Taylor was employed by Walton & Company, York, PA, where he began building a promising career.

He leaves behind his beloved mother, Melissa A. Colburn (McGarry); his loving grandparents, Deborah McGarry (Benoit) and her husband James; his special aunt, Elizabeth Sanna (McGarry) married to husband Nicholas, parents to Nicholas James. 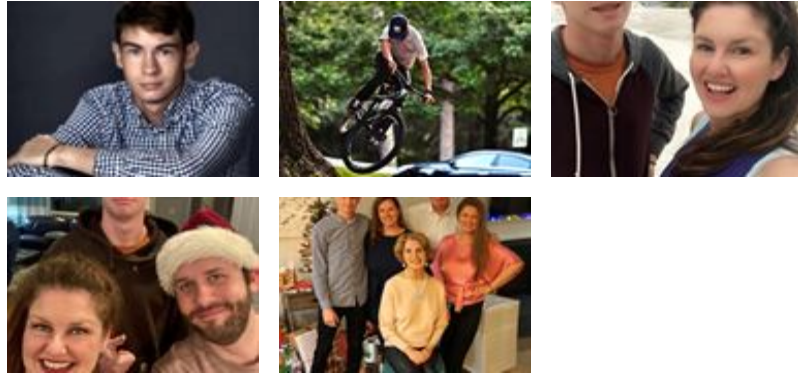

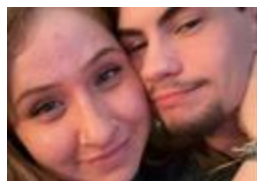
