Thomas Wayne Nolt, 68, of Columbia, PA, passed away on Thursday, September 27, 2012, under Hospice care in Lebanon, PA.

Born in Lancaster, PA, on August 27, 1944, he was the son of the late J. Paul Nolt and Mary Keiser Nolt. He is survived by two brothers, Joseph P., husband of Marianne S. Nolt, and Samuel K., married to Joyce W. Nolt. Surviving also are nephews Joseph P. Nolt III, Jeffrey F. Nolt, Suzannah C. Nold, and Kristin Nolt Wingard. Tom was predeceased by his nephew Timothy D. Nolt.

A 1963 graduate of J.P. McCaskey High School, Tom was a member of the Order of DeMolay in Lancaster. Following graduation, he worked as a window designer for Hager's Department Store. From March 1968 to March 1971, Tom proudly served as a Specialist Five in the U.S. Army. He was awarded the Bronze Star Medal for Meritorious achievement in ground operations against hostile forces in the Republic of Vietnam.

A talented floral designer, Tom briefly operated a flower stand at Central Market, Lancaster. He later owned and managed flower shops, including Scenes of Greenery, York, PA and Gene's Florist, Gaithersburg, MD.

He was an avid animal lover, and was especially fond of his Scottie dogs and collections of related Scottish memorabilia.
