Virginia Briner Anderson, 89, of Willow Street, Penn., died peacefully on Sunday, June 30, 2013 at Willow Valley Lakeside. She was the daughter of Robert and Catharine Briner and the wife of Raymond Anderson for 9 years. Born July 18, 1923 in Philadelphia, she was raised in Drexel Hill.

Virginia graduated from Upper Darby HS and Drexel University with a B.S. in Home Economics. Later she received her M.A. in Sociology from the University of Penn. She taught home economics at Colwyn Independent School for 12 years and at Lansdowne Aldan High School for 28 years. Virginia moved to Willow Street from Drexel Hill in 1999.

She was a member of Christ Presbyterian Church for 61 years, serving as an elder and co-treasurer, and more recently attended Grace Church at Willow Valley. She worked with the Meals on Wheels organization for many years. Virginia was a sweet, loving person who made friends everywhere she went. She enjoyed traveling, reading, sewing and quilting, and walking.

Surviving in addition to her husband are a step-daughter, Sally Cook (James) of Lititz, and a step-son, Keith Anderson (Sarah) of Grand Rapids, Mich. She is also survived by 7 grandchildren, 6 great-grandchildren, 2 nieces and 2 nephews and their children. She was preceded in death by another step-son, Craig Anderson (Peggy) of Lansing, Mich.; a twin sister, Harriet Briner of

Willow Street; and a brother, Dr. Donald Briner (Betty) of Traverse City, Mich.
