Wilfred W. "Bill" Shively, 89, of Lancaster, PA, died on Saturday, June 29, 2013. Bill was born in Shindle, PA. Bill and Josephine Isaacson Shively celebrated 36 years of marriage.

Four days after turning 18, Bill enlisted in the U.S. Army, and fought in North Africa and Italy during WWII. His distinguished wartime military service was recognized with a Purple Heart and a Bronze Star among other honors. Bill went on to a career in the Air Force military police in Maryland and Virginia. Following his military service, Bill worked for RCA in TV tube manufacturing. Bill is remembered as a devoted family man. A proud member of the VFW and American Legion, he enjoyed playing golf at Evergreen Golf Club.

In addition to his wife, Bill is survived by his three daughters: Donna Collins, wife of Butch, of Mt. Joy, PA; Tina White, wife of Randy, of Blue Grass, IA; and Roberta Graybill of Elizabethtown, PA.
