William W. “Bill” Kopetz, 82, passed away on Friday, March 6, 2026, at Moravian Manor, Lititz surrounded by his family. He was born in Pittsburgh and was the son of the late George E. and Mary Lou (Klingensmith) Kopetz. He was the loving husband of 58 years to Mary Ellen (Dolina) Kopetz.

He was the retired president of PrecisionForm, Inc. (PFI). He is an alumnus of Shady Side Academy and Northwestern University, with a stop at Concordia Theological Seminary. He spent over twenty years in various sales, marketing, and general management positions with the Aluminum Company of America (ALCOA) before joining PFI in 1987. He had a very successful career and retired in 2011.
