William O Frailey IV of Lancaster died peacefully on Tuesday morning at Hospice of Lancaster County in Mount Joy. Born in Lancaster PA on March 31, 1941 he was the only son of William O. Frailey III and Martha Sullivan Frailey.

Bill graduated from Lancaster Catholic High School and received a B.A. degree in Economics from the University of Notre Dame and an MBA from the University of Arkansas. He was a veteran of the US Air Force and served several tours in Viet Nam, leaving the service with the rank of Captain. Resettling in Lancaster to raise his family, Bill was employed for 20 years as an insurance agent for Metropolitan Life. Upon retirement he worked part-time for the Manheim Auto Auction. Bill was a parishoner of Sacred Heart of Jesus Church where he served for many years a lector. He was a member of the Knights of Columbus and served as Judge of Elections in the West End. While Bill was very interested in politics and cars, his special joy came from the pride he took in his children and grandchildren.

Bill is survived by his daughter Monica wife of Tony Kirchner, son Brian husband of Pannida Frailey all of Lancaster and five grandchildren: Kylie, Sydney and Maya Kirchner and Orion and Tahra Frailey.
